Will have four lines.... two for hamburgers and two for chicken dinners. Mike Martin will help overall for set-up, parking, etc. as trouble shooter.

We will count the tickets that are placed in the bags this year to let us know if the gifts have good response from the crowd. People will count the money in their department. This will be for a double check for the final count of all proceeds.

Class tents have been ordered for the years of '42, '45 & '46, '47, '48, '52, '56, '62, '63, and '64.

Judy Johnson will report to the crowd the total attendance for each class.

We talked about having cars in next year's parade to advertise the All Class Picnic.

Joanna Bruno reported that she has looked into purchasing and brought samples of magnets, Christmas ornaments, cups with the logo, etc. that we could sell at the picnic. T-shirts are available and she suggested that we all wear them at the picnic so the crowd could become interested. We can use some mugs for gifts to the "Oldest member attending the picnic, etc. Orders taken for our items at the picnic will have a \$5.00 shipping charge. Joanna was given permission to order \$100 worth of items to display at the picnic. After much discussion Marlene Mendoza made a motion that we table the ordering and shipping until next year since we have such a short time to make decisions. Irene Johnson seconded the motion. It was decided that in the future all expenses shall be pre-approved by the Board before presentation to the membership. We can discuss if we wish to start the advertising in the newsletter.
