FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT: Jerry Jewett reported that we had purchased \$60,000 of Thornbuilder Mutual Funds from the D. A. Davidson funds. We will purchase \$40,000 of insured Government bonds when a good interest rate comes up for purchase. The total amount to be invested at Edward Jones is \$125,000. This decision was made after reviewing the March Financial statement.

PICNIC REPORT: Pat Hyatt reported. The food ticket count on the day of the picnic was 315.

Fifty four meal tickets were sold at the picnic.

Memberships were sold at the picnic at \$10 each

3 Lifetime memberships at \$100 each: \$300

Ten meals were sold after the picnic: \$50
